

Challenge Course

The Challenge Course (or "Low Ropes" Course) is a series of outdoor problem solving activities designed to build teamwork and leadership skills. Each activity is led by Camp Staff members in three steps: (1) the challenge is set up, (2) the group works together to solve the challenge, and (3) a debriefing session occurs.

Examples of our challenge course include: Ground-based teambuilding games, Racoon Circles, Spider Web, Birthday Log, Nitro Crossing, and The Trolley. All elements are led in a safe manner by trained staff.

The course can be used for as little as one hour, or a half day.

Collin County Adventure Camp also has a climbing wall, which is led by trained camp staff. The wall is located near the Dining Hall.
